Motion to Approve Agenda – Ben Pantoja

The meeting agenda was sent out prior to the meeting. Ben Pantoja motioned to approve the June meeting agenda, Jan seconded the motion. The agenda was approved unanimously.

Motion to Approve May Minutes – Owen Waller

The minutes were sent out to board members prior to the meeting. Owen motioned to approve the minutes, Jan seconded. The minutes were unanimously approved.

Fire Report – Cincinnati Fire Dept. (CFD)

No report this month.

Clifton Branch Library update - Jeanne Strauss de Groote

No report this month, a comprehensive list of June's Clifton Branch Library events was emailed out with the agenda.

Clifton Recreation Center - David Daniel

The first day of CRC's 10 week summer camp began the day of the meeting. There were 120 kids, 20 group leaders, and countless pictures, crafts, and popsicles. The theme for the summer camp this year is gardening. A small garden has been started at the CRC to help teach the kids about plant life, gardening, and other related topics including composting.

David explained that the CRC would also be doing a wakeboarding program. Information can be found online or at the community board.

America's River Roots - Chris Horn

Chris explained that America's River Roots is hosting a festival celebrating Cincinnati's river-city heritage. The festival will span from Paul Brown Stadium to the Boathouse in Covington and is expected to host 1 million visitors. There will be headlining artists at Smale park, riverboat cruises, and many other activities.

Q: Has the headliner had been announced?

A: The announcement was a few weeks out but America's River Roots has booked some big acts.

Q: Are there other River Roots festivals along the Ohio river?

A: Though there are small celebrations, no other city has a celebration planned on the same scale currently.

Q: Is America's River Roots partnering with metro or providing parking by the river?

A: America's River Roots are working on parking and transportation plans.

Q: Are the events (beer/bourbon experience, concerts, etc) ticketed?

A: Some of the headlining concerts and food/drink experiences are ticketed, however the festival is free and there will be a free sightseeing app to guide visitors to points of interest.

Q: Is America's River Roots working with a local promoter like Riverbend?

A: No, America's River Roots is working with a music producer in Atlanta. She is looking into the musicology of the river

Chris encouraged everyone to get involved if you are a merchandise vendor, food truck owner, dance group, music act, etc. The website is https://www.americasriverroots.com/, and the app is Freedom Journey on the app store.

SWORT Utility Reform - Steve Goodin

The SWORT representative was not present at the meeting. The board decided to delay the topic and move forward through the agenda until the SWORT representative arrived.

Change to Membership Web Page Motion 1 - Ben Pantoja

Ben motioned to change the membership page on the website to add the membership list of CTM. The list will have names and membership status but no addresses or phone numbers. The motion is meant to make it easier for CTM members to figure out if their membership has expired.

The motion was seconded by Barry and unanimously approved. Motion 1 is attached at the end of the minutes.

Nominations for CTM Vacancies Motion 2 - Ben Pantoja

Ben motioned to appoint Bridget Waller and Robert DiMartino to the board to fill vacancies from Tim Noonan and Brenden Pulte. Both new board members will be on the finance committee and share responsibilities of the treasurer role.

The motion was seconded by Gerald and unanimously approved. The full wording of Motion 2 is attached at the end of the minutes.

Traffic Safety at Glenmary Motion 3 - Justin Ogilby

Motion 3 is to ask DOTE about extending the planned Bryant bike lane to Glenmary.

An audience member explained that he and his daughters had been nearly hit at the crosswalk from Bryant ave towards Lorraine st crossing Clifton ave three times in the past week. First, a car ran the second red light in the intersection going southbound during a white crosswalk signal. Second, a car turned left from Glenmary onto Clifton ave and ran the red light not realizing there was a second traffic signal. Third, a car sped through the intersection going southbound similar to the first case.

Discussions of traffic calming at the intersection included the possibility of making the traffic light at Lorraine St and Clifton Ave a flashing red or closing off Lorraine St at Clifton Ave. The board and audience discussed the traffic implications of the solutions.

Justin motioned to send the letter requesting to extend the bike lane to DOTE, Gerald seconded the motion. The letter and motion language is attached at the end of the minutes.

Traffic Safety at Glenmary Motion 3.5 - Ben Pantoja

Ben motioned to send a letter to DOTE asking for traffic safety interventions for problem intersections along Clifton Ave. This letter, which will be edited by Justin to include data of traffic problems connected by the Transportation community, will be sent to DOTE to request assistance in finding traffic solutions.

Jan seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously. The draft of the letter, to be edited by Justin and sent, is attached at the end of the minutes.

Clifton Boundaries Motion 4 - Justin Ogilby

The motion was skipped to talk about Clifton boundaries motions 5 and 6.

Clifton Boundaries Motion 5 & Motion 6- Ben Pantoja

Ben presented a slideshow with the history of Clifton's boundaries, explained the difference between the City's recognized boundaries and how that pertains to the Clifton Plan's boundaries, and read off the emails from City Planning included in the presentation. The presentation is attached to the minutes and includes the City's recommendation to move forward with the City's boundaries in the Clifton Plan due to the circumstances of the overlapping boundaries.

Audience members spoke and shared their perspectives:

- -Sam Debree spoke in dissent of motions 5 and 6 and also expressed frustration with the waterline replacements along Bishop.
- -David Logan shared that he had lived on South Bishop St for 36 years and expressed concern for development along Bishop street. He pushed for south Bishop to be included in Clifton's Plan boundaries.
- -Malcolm Montgomery spoke concerned with the format of the discussion around motions 5 and 6 citing lack of time for residents to speak about complex issues. He worried that not including all bylaws members in the Clifton Plan boundaries would set a bad precedent for the Clifton Plan.
- -William Messer explained he had lived on South Bishop for 30 years. He said he once mistakenly received a map in an email where his and his neighbors' houses were replaced with a small development. He further explained that he had felt like he lived in Clifton.
- -Rachel Wells spoke and said that Bishop st residents should not have to choose to be represented by a single community council or the other citing that each community council is an independent non-profit that can care about the same population. She encouraged broader engagement with Corryville's Community Council and residents on Bishop street.
- -John Bressler introduced himself as a Clifton resident for nearly 50 years. He pointed out that the original reason south bishop street was added to CTM's

bylaws boundaries was because of a request from residents to be better represented.

-Lisa Haglund attempted to address motions 5 and 6 but was not able to speak on the motions due to technical issues.

Board discussions included that CTM could not include south Bishop st due to Corryville's stance on the shared boundary. Owen proposed a substitute motion on motion 5, motioning to engage with overlapping/neighboring community councils through the housing and zoning committee meetings. He explained the committee would attempt to resolve issues between community councils and residents in the shared boundaries. Board members and audience members alike shared concern for the timeline of the Clifton Plan.

Steve seconded the substitute motion. Board members clarified that the substitute motion would specifically request that neighborhood boards vote to either approve or disapprove of sharing the overlapping areas in the Clifton Plan Boundaries.

The board voted unanimously to carry out the substitute motion.

Committee Roll Call

Finance Committee – Acting treasurer: Gerald Checco

Gerald motioned to amend the budget to be increased by \$400 under the arts committee to allow for promotion of the Off-Ludlow gallery.

Ben seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously to approve the budget adjustment

Adjournment - Next CTM Board Meeting 7/7.

The meeting was adjourned after the finance committee update due to the meeting going over time.

Motion to adjourn called by Ben, seconded by Gerald, and was unanimously approved (U).



Motion 1 Change in Membership Page

Motion to revise the Membership page of the <u>Cliftoncommunity.org</u> website such that the user can check if their membership is current. Membership list would be updated at least every 3 months and would include no information except member names (no emails, addresses, or other information besides membership status)



Motion 2

This moves to appoint two new trustees to the CTM Board to fill vacancies. Appoint Bridget Waller and Robert DiMartino effective June 4th, 2025. They will fill the vacancies from Tim Noonan, who has already resigned and Brenden Pulte who is resigning effective June 3rd. Both Bridget and Robert have finance backgrounds. This is exactly what CTM needs right now given that Tim Noonan's retirement has created a vacancy in the Treasurer position. The financial tasks of CTM are best shared by a Financial Committee with at least two trustees. Gerald Checco will continue as interim Treasurer until a transition can be completed.

Motion 3 - Glenmary Traffic Safety Justin's Motion

We request that DOTE evaluate improvements to the intersections of Clifton Ave / Bryant Ave and Clifton Ave / Glenmary Ave designed to make crossing Clifton Ave, Bryant Ave and Glenmary Ave safer for pedestrians. The improvements would be installed quickly and target these resident-identified problems:

- 1. Red-light running on Clifton at Bryant and Glenmary intersections makes it dangerous for pedestrians to cross Clifton. Drivers either fail to see one of the two closely-spaced traffic lights or ignore one set of lights in order to "make the next one."
- Inattentive drivers turning from Clifton onto Glenmary sometimes fail to see pedestrians crossing Glenmary.

We hope you can find resources to address these problems quickly and look forward to collaborating with you on a solution.




Motion for Glenmary Traffic Safety

This moves that CTM approve Justin sending out a letter to DOTE with the following basic idea (Justin to choose final wording):

Due to multiple traffic safety issues at Clifton and Glenmary, the Transportation Committee and the Board of Clifton Town Meeting request that DOTE evaluate the following:

 A bike lane extension from Clifton to Bryant has already been approved and is planned for construction in Spring of 2026. If and only if this can be done with existing funding and with zero impact on schedule, we would like DOTE to consider extending the bike lane about 100 feet further such that it reaches Glenmary. See images below. This would provide northbound traffic calming all the way to Glenmary to improve pedestrian safety.





Motion 3.5
Motion for Letter on Clifton Redesign

This moves that CTM send the draft letter below to DOTE in late June or early July. Justin is free to first revise the draft to list some of the other problem areas in a list maintained by the Transportation Committee and to set priorities on the problems:

To: Director of Cincinnati Department of Transportation and Engineering.

Subject: Redesign of Clifton Avenue

Dear -----

In 2024, CTM began working with DOTE on a Clifton Avenue Redesign project. The intent of this project was to define short and long term improvements for a variety of traffic safety issues on Clifton Avenue from Ludlow Avenue to Lafayette Avenue. See the attached letters from various Clifton community organizations expressing support for this project.

One step has been taken. CTM and DOTE are moving ahead in 2026 with installing an extension of the Clifton Avenue bicycle lane from Ludlow Avenue to Bryant. However, this is only a start. It does not address all the safety issues on Clifton Avenue. This letter, approved by the CTM Board on 7/7/2025, requests that DOTE make additional short and long term suggestions in the next few months for the full length of the Clifton Avenue Redesign. The Transportation Committee has had some ideas but would appreciate DOTE's expertise to generate more ideas.

Ideally, these suggestions should consider some of the following issues:

- Southbound Clifton Avenue drivers speeding through the intersections of Glenmary and Bryant when the lights turn yellow and sometimes even when they are red.
- Clifton Avenue drivers failing to yield to pedestrians at Glenmary when the "Walk" sign is active.
- Current traffic light phasing at Woolper and McAlpin intersections which does not allow traffic to clear the intersection during each phase.
- Clifton Avenue drivers failing to yield to pedestrians at Woolper when the "Walk" sign is active.
- Difficult turns from Lafayette to Clifton.
- Speeding in those sections of Clifton Avenue that have 2 northbound lanes or 2 southbound lanes.
- Hasty left turns from Hosea to Clifton

Some of DOTE's suggestions could be long term and require funding, but others such as changes in traffic signals probably could be implemented quickly to increase safety as soon as possible. Also, if DOTE provides suggestions soon, these ideas could be incorporated into the Clifton Plan that CTM is now updating in collaboration with the Cincinnati Planning Department.

Motion on 24/7 parking

Justin Ogilby to inform DOTE that:

- The President of the Clifton Business Association wants parking on the west side of Clifton Avenue between Bryant to Ludlow shown below to be metered during standard business hours (9am to 6pm Monday to Saturday). This is a follow up to the May 2025 CTM vote requesting that DOTE remove the no parking during rush hour restriction on these parking spaces.
- 2. Clifton Town Meeting (CTM) Transportation Committee and Board of Trustees are open to whatever DOTE decides






Strategy for Clifton Plan Boundaries



City versus CTM Clifton Boundaries

- City boundaries (CCJ or Community Council Jurisdictions)
 and CTM boundaries agreed starting in 1961
- In 1977, CTM dropped the Vine Street Cemetery
- In 1983, CTM added areas that, then and now, are only in other neighborhoods according to the City's boundaries
 - Bishop south of Jefferson and most of Burnet Woods are only in the City's Corryville boundary
 - The rest of Burnet Woods and the Good Sam triangle are only in the City's CUF boundary
- CCJ Boundaries have not changed





Areas added by CTM in 1983

Letter from Planning

Highlights:

- Only CCJ and Statistical Boundaries are recognized
- Planning explored option to include In Clifton Plan the areas in CTM boundaries that are not in CCJ: Bishop, Burnet Woods, and Good Sam Triangle
- Option was contingent on support from Corryville and CUF because these areas are in their CCJ boundaries
- Corryville objected
- Planning now recommends that "the Clifton Plan boundary use the Community Council Jurisdictions recognized by the City (Exhibit B) and include a section for "Neighboring Areas of Interests" that includes public feedback on areas that concern CTM and the neighborhood."

Good morning, Ben,

Below is an update to the Clifton Plan boundary and details of the Department of City Planning and Engagement's notification policy. Please share with your CTM and Clifton constituents. Let me know if you have any questions or comments.

Clifton Plan Boundary

The City of Cincinnati recognizes two boundaries – the Community Council Jurisdictions and the Statistical Neighborhood Approximations, as mapped and available on our website <u>City of Cincinnati - Frequently Requested Maps</u>.

The *Community Council Jurisdictions* (CCJ) boundary was drafted based on Community Council boundaries in 2018 that were approved by city council and filed with the clerk at the time. It is used to notify Community Councils.

The Statistical Neighborhood Approximations (SNA) are geographic boundaries that are designed to align with Census data, even when those boundaries don't exactly match established community or community council boundaries. SNAs are used to provide data for areas not specifically defined by standard Census geographies. The SNA Boundary layer is redrawn every ten years after the Census.

Due to the expressed concerns from Clifton residents regarding the boundary used for the ongoing Clifton Plan not aligning with the Clifton boundary approved by Clifton Town Meeting (CTM) as identified in the community council's bylaws, the Department of City Planning and Engagement (DCPE) explored options to expand the plan boundary to include the additional land as recognized by CTM's bylaws (*Exhibit A, Area #1*) and which overlap with Corryville and CUF neighborhood boundaries. Including the overlap areas in the Clifton Plan boundary was contingent on support from the overlap community councils and inviting the communities into the Clifton planning process to provide input on the overlap recommendations.

Staff from DCPE met with the Corryville Community Council president on April 29, 2025, to discuss the overlap areas' inclusion in the Clifton Plan boundary. The Corryville president was adamant that the community council does not support the overlap areas being included in the Clifton Plan boundary. The idea of a plan section for "Neighboring Areas of Interest" was discussed, where Clifton residents can address recommendations and concerns for periphery areas that impact the neighborhood, such as Burnet Woods and Bishop Street. The Corryville president supported this idea, understanding that the plan language addressing areas within the Corryville neighborhood is shared with the community council later in the planning process. The response from Corryville was confirmed by CTM's president, who discussed the same topic with Corryville's president the following day.

Moving forward, DCPE recommends that the Clifton Plan boundary use the Community Council Jurisdictions recognized by the City (Exhibit B) and include a section for "Neighboring Areas of Interests" that includes public feedback on areas that concern CTM and the neighborhood. All community councils where the plan language is included in the Clifton Plan will have an opportunity to provide input on the language applicable to their neighborhood. CTM is encouraged to vote on the above recommendation.

CTM Notification

The following responses are regarding the letter to the Director of Planning sent by Clifton Town Meeting on April 7, 2025 (Exhibit C).

The Department of City Planning and Engagement (DCPE) uses the *Community Council Jurisdictions* (CCJ) boundaries (Exhibit B) when notifying community councils. In other words, for Clifton, the DCPE does not use the CTM boundary to notify the community council, only the CCJ boundary. The DCPE notifies community councils within 400' of a zone change or Planned Development subject property for public staff conferences, City Planning Commission meetings, and City Council's Equitable Growth and Housing Committee per §111-5 Notice and Hearings on Notwithstanding Ordinances (Municipal Code - §111-5); 200' for subdivisions per §300-09. –Major Subdivision Procedure(a)(3) (Cincinnati Subdivision Regulations); and adjacent for real estate items (dedications, easements, vacations, sales, leases, etc.). In addition, developers and/or applicants are encouraged to engage with the applicable community councils during the preliminary review and/or application submission and are given the community council's contact information.

A map amendment can be requested to update the CCJ boundary to match the CTM boundary. The DCPE recommends the following steps for the map amendment:

- 1. Work with all community councils within any overlapping areas.
- 2. Receive written agreements from all overlapping community councils.
- Request a map amendment to DCPE.
- 4. Receive approval from the City Planning Commission.
- 5. Receive approval from the City Council.

Best,

Opportunity: Add Burnet Woods to CCJ

- Goal: CTM wishes to receive notifications for zoning and developments on South Bishop, Burnet Woods, and the Good Sam Triangle
- Notifications are not based on CTM boundaries. If we want notifications, this could be accomplished by following City Planning's process to amend the CCJ such that Burnet Woods is shared by Clifton, Corryville, and CUF
 - All 3 neighborhoods would receive notifications on South Bishop and Good Sam Triangle because these would be within 400 feet of Burnet Woods
- Planning, Corryville, and CUF have previously stated that they are open to this strategy

Opportunity: Add Burnet Woods to CCJ

Motion: accept Planning's recommendation

- This moves that CTM accept City Planning's recommendation to use the CCJ boundaries for the Clifton Plan and add a section for "Neighboring Areas of Interest" which CTM develops in collaboration with Corryville and CUF Community Councils. This added section enables CTM to advocate for those areas such as South Bishop that are within the CTM boundaries but outside of the boundaries recognized by City Planning.




