### **Motion to Approve Agenda – Ben Pantoja**

The meeting agenda was sent out prior to the meeting. Ben moved to approve the minutes. A second was not given before the board unanimously approved the motion. The meeting's agenda was approved.

### **Motion to Approve April Meeting Minutes – Owen Waller**

April Minutes were emailed out to the board prior to the meeting. Owen motioned to approve minutes, Ben seconded. The minutes were unanimously approved.

### **Fire Report – Lieutenant Dave Owens, Cincinnati Fire Dept.**

Lieutenant Owens provided the number of runs for Engine 34: 216 total runs and 185 in Clifton specifically. Owens explained that residents should keep their address easily visible from the street (mailbox, curb, etc) to assist CFD in identifying the house if an emergency is called. Residents should also turn lights on after calling.

A CFD recruitment class is graduating in a couple of months, with all recruits having finished their EMT school and state certification.

An audience member asked about SMART 9-1-1, where you can enter medical information about a household (number of residents, preexisting conditions, etc) so CFD can have that information before arriving at the scene. Lieutenant Owens explained that any resident can google the SMART 9-1-1 service and sign up through the City of Cincinnati's website.

A board member asked the Lieutenant how many drug overdoses were happening in Clifton and if it was increasing. Owens explained that overdoses were trending downward, though when unsafe batches arrive in town there are temporary spikes, but overdoses go back down after that. He explained that efforts to supply community members with Narcan and educate the public had probably helped the downward trend of ODs.

### **Clifton Recreation Center - Brittany Havens**

Brittany highlighted the CRCs upcoming River Track program, which is in its 29th year, where teens go out to the Little Miami for 5 days and camp out each night.

CRC has been preparing for summer programs as well as their summer camp, and the Buy-Nothing-Swap was well attended and very successful. Brittany thanked all the volunteers and participants from the past weekend.

### **Clifton Branch Library update - Jeanne Strauss de Groot**

Jeanne introduced herself to the audience and announced a few of the upcoming month's programs.

On Saturday, May 9th from 12pm - 3pm, the library will host their annual Lemonade on the Lawn, an outdoor LGBTQ health and wellness fair at the Clifton Branch Library providing resources to people of all ages and identities.

On Saturday, May 16th from 11am - 1pm the library will host its annual plant club. This includes plant swaps, games, and learning opportunities from local organizations.

On Monday, May 18th the library will begin an "Ethics & Dragons" D&D series hosted by UC's Ethics Center to help ages 11-18 to understand nuanced ethical issues through a fictional lens.

Finally, on Saturday May 30th from 11am - 1pm the library will host a kick-off of the Library's Summer Reading Program. There will be music, games on the lawn, and a free book for every kid who signs up.

Ben let everyone know that the new website review had happened last month, with another review set for June. The designer is working to mimic the current website but bring an updated user-interface. Board members will be trained on how to update the website once it is complete.

### **Events – Lindsay Wile**

Lindsay reported on the planning of the Memorial Day Parade. The CCAC will be hosting bike decorating from 10am - 12pm on Saturday before the Parade. The UC ROTC is going to be joining in the parade and marching in uniform, the fire department will also be in the parade. The Cincinnati Skatepark Project will also march in the parade. Schools in the neighborhood have been encouraged to participate, and the Cincinnati PUP group will be providing goodie bags.

Lindsay also announced that the Mother's Day Home and Garden tour will be held this year with 8 houses to be toured.

### **Governance – Ben Pantoja**

Next month's meeting will be a membership meeting to vote on the bylaws adjustment to reduce the size of the board from 15 to 13.

### **Housing & Zoning – Owen Waller**

Owen explained that Housing and Zoning met and discussed ways for the committee to more quickly respond to zoning variances. It was decided that, if a CTM board meeting was not held between notification and the hearing of a variance, the H&Z committee would call upon the executive committee to send either a prewritten letter of opposition or non-opposition depending on the H&Z and executive committee opinion.

### **Membership & Nominating – Barry Gee**

### **Public Safety – Aaron Weiner**

Ben explained that our neighborhood's CPD liaison, Officer Dent, had lost his son this past weekend. Dent's 26 year-old son lived out of town in New Orleans and was shot. A website had been created to help Dent's family with funeral costs, transportation, etc. Jan put a link out on the Facebook page and WCPO wrote an article about the tragedy.

Jan moved to have Ben send a letter to Officer Dent's family offering condolences and sympathy. Ben was trusted to write the letter on behalf of the board. Aaron seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.

### **Transportation – Bob Seigel**

The Transportation committee met the past month and focused on the Clifton-Woolper-McAlpin intersection. The BRT ad hoc committee is still meeting with Metro, hoping to give input on the station design. The City told the transportation committee that the Clifton Ave concrete speed bumps would be installed in late June, and the bike lane extension should follow shortly after.

### **Neighborhood Support Program (NSP) Liaison – Barry Gee**

Barry explained that he had been reaching out to the NSP team to ask about the reimbursement of NSP funds already spent. Barry is also working with them to secure the certificate of insurance to rent Mt Storm park for the Memorial Day Parade and Picnic.

**End of Committee Reports**

**Clifton Deer Program Update – Laurie Briggs and Garret Parsons**

Laurie Briggs and Garret Parsons are both founding members of the Clifton Deer Program; they presented an update of their progress since the last update around 2016. In 2016, Clifton Town Meeting provided a matching grant of \$2,500 in the program's first year. Since then, the Clifton Deer Program has been humanely reducing the deer population within Clifton.

Laurie turned it over to questions from the audience. Ben asked whether Clifton Deer was still running on a research permit. Laurie explained that while she hoped Ohio DNR would review the research and issue a management permit, Ohio DNR continues to renew the research permit and benefit from the study of the results.

Peggy asked why Clifton Deer uses ovariectomies on female deer rather than sterilizing a single male buck. Laurie explained that this was due to deer herd behavior. Female doe stay within a mile of where they are born, but male bucks tend to travel widely. Thus if a female deer population was fertile, a single travelling buck could restart the herd's overpopulation.

Jan-Michele asked why ovariectomies were used instead of other contraceptive methods. Laurie answered that contraceptives are effective for a maximum of 2 years, and long-lived doe would need to be tracked and readministered instead of tagged and sterilized a single time.

Kevin M. asked whether Clifton Deer would stop sterilizing at a certain point of population/sq mi. Laurie answered that 20ish deer/sq mi was a target, and at that point Clifton Deer would continue to monitor the population and selectively sterilize as needed.

Owen jokingly asked whether the Clifton Deer program planned on writing a sequel to Bambi where the book focuses on educating kids about ovariectomies and non-lethal population control. Laurie let Owen know that if CTM wanted to collaborate on a book publishing Clifton Deer would split the money raised.

#### **Website Update – Ben Pantoja**

This was covered in the communications committee update.

#### **Clifton Plan Update – Gerald Checco**

Gerald explained that the final draft of the Clifton plan was to arrive shortly, followed by 1-2 more community engagement sessions in June and July. This is after a year and a half of engagement and drafting from CTM and Kyle Gibbs from the City's Planning and Community Engagement department. The plan is to be submitted finally for CTM board approval at the August meeting.

#### **Community Questions & Concerns – Ben Pantoja**

Gerald explained he was participating in a fundraising effort to purchase the large hillside near Lafayette and donate it to Cincinnati Parks Foundation, making Mt Storm the fourth largest park in the foundation. There will be a kick-off meeting on June 2nd at Alive & Well at 5:30pm. Jan Michele mentioned that the City of Cincinnati had a Quick-Strike fund for neighborhoods looking to take ownership of community landmarks that for whatever reason go up for sale. Gerald responded that Quick-Strike money may not be best utilized in this case.

Peggy asked whether Clifton or the City of Cincinnati had any plans for the car dealerships on Mitchell Ave. Jan responded that the City of Cincinnati's "Revive

I-75" plan was meant to help the entire Mill Creek corridor and transform it into usable recreation space.

**Adjournment - Next CTM Board Meeting 6/1.**

Motion to adjourn called by Jan, seconded by Ben, and was unanimously approved.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30.

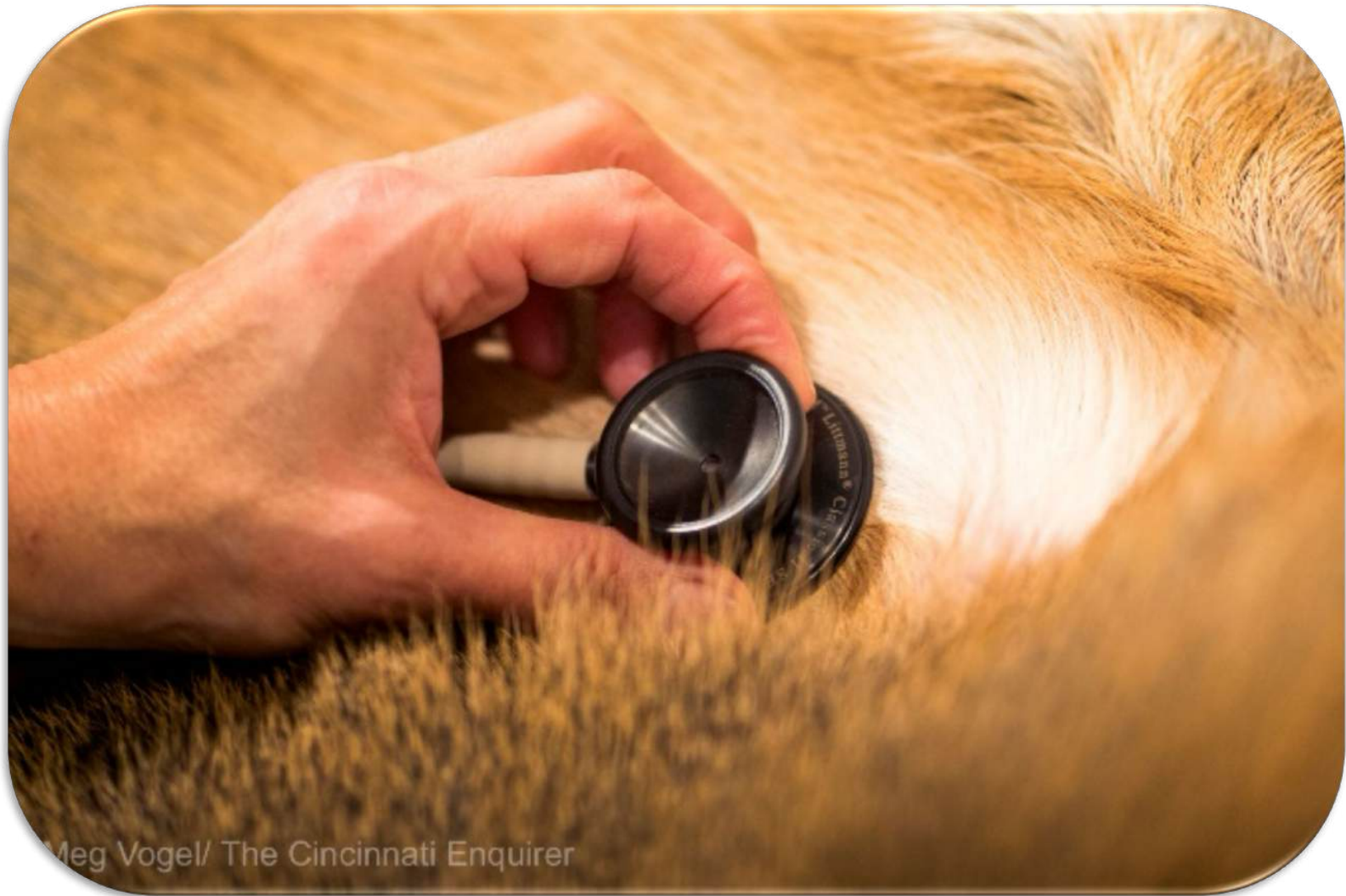

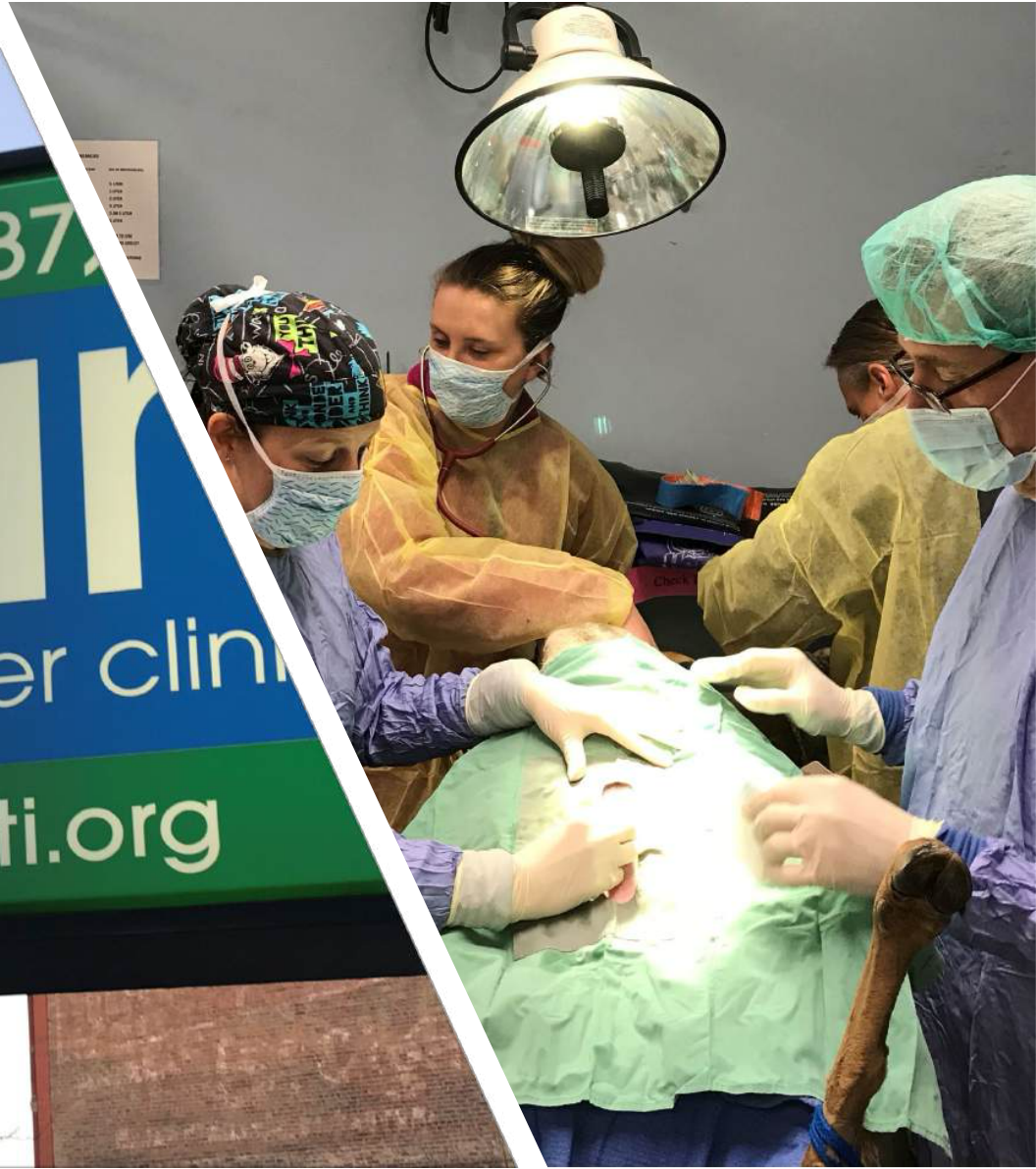

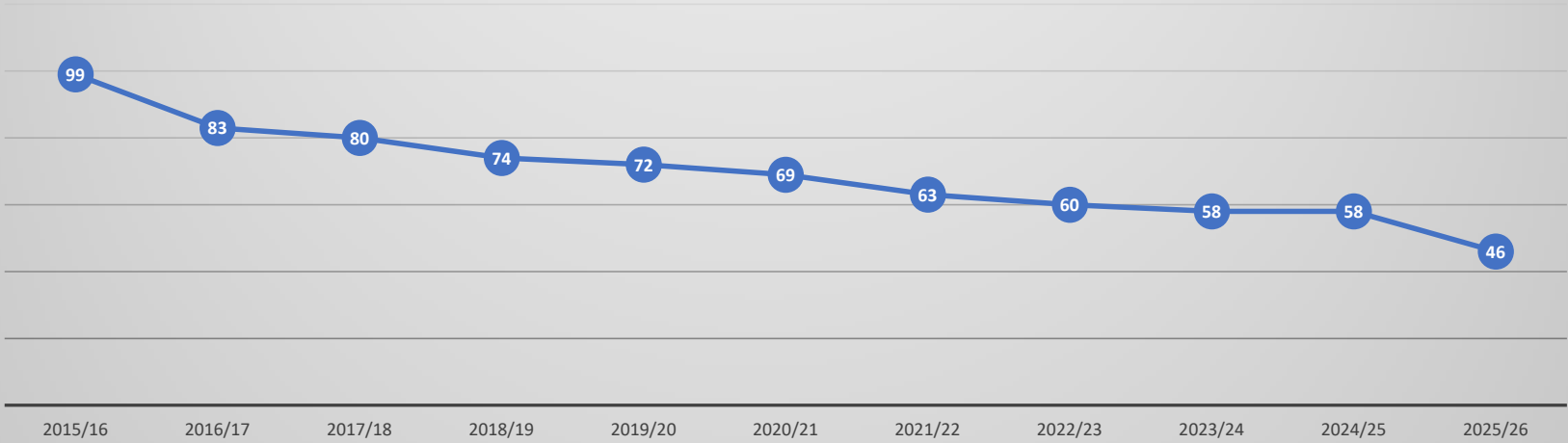

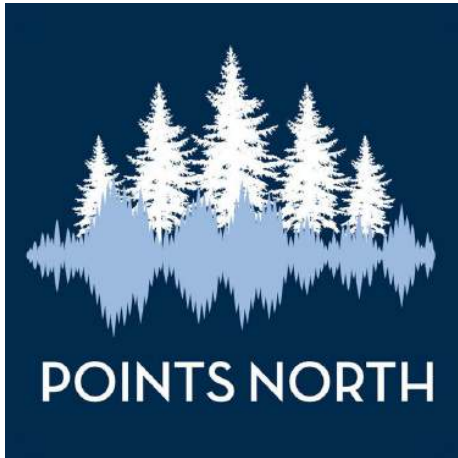
### Deer Per Square Mile

## Ovariectomy As a Management Technique for Suburban Deer Populations

**ABSTRACT** Overabundant suburban deer (*Odocoileus* spp.) are a source of human-wildlife conflict in many communities throughout the United States. Deer-vehicle collisions, impacts to local vegetation, tick-borne pathogens, and other negative interactions are typical reasons cited for initiating deer management programs. Social attitudes, legal constraints, and perceived safety concerns lead many communities to examine nonlethal management options. Surgical sterilization is currently the only nonlethal method available to permanently sterilize females with a single treatment. However, there are limited data demonstrating methods and outcomes in management programs that sterilize a high percentage (>90%) of local populations of females, particularly regarding the impact of immigration on non-isolated populations. We present data from 6 surgical sterilization sites with geographically open populations in California, Maryland, Michigan, New York, Ohio, and Virginia, USA. From 2012 to 2020 we sterilized 493 deer, primarily via ovariectomy, and conducted annual or periodic population estimates using camera surveys, road-based distance sampling, and intensive field observations to assess population trends. Study sites ranged from 1.2 km<sup>2</sup> to 16.5 km<sup>2</sup> with ~47–169 individuals, resulting in approximate densities of 6–63 deer/km<sup>2</sup>. For all sites we noted an average reduction of ~26% (17%–36%) from Year 1 to Year 2. Four years after initial treatment, we documented an average population reduction of ~45% (29%–56%). During the first year, the average cost per deer sterilized at locations where bait was used was US\$1,185 (\$927–\$1,572). Surgical sterilization projects demonstrate that significant reductions in local deer densities using high-percentage, surgical sterilization programs can be achieved in non-insular locations, where baited deer are approachable by vehicle for darting. Sustained sterilization efforts may be necessary, as is the case with all deer management programs, in areas where immigration is possible, and all the animals are not sterilized. © 2021 The Wildlife Society.
