Clifton Town Meeting (CTM) is the Community Council of the neighborhood of Clifton. Per the City of Cincinnati "The Cincinnati Community Council Boundaries layer is an assemblage of maps of each distinct Cincinnati neighborhood. Community councils are nonprofit voluntary organizations that weigh in on city matters but exist separately from the city government and follow different rules. Each neighborhood council has defined its own border which in some cases are not in agreement with other contiguous neighborhood boundaries resulting in areas of overlap in the layer. The City of Cincinnati does not intervene or mediate on these boundary discrepancies."
