

## Special Vote per City Ordinance 220-1989

### Ballot Question

**“Shall CTM Members that are not neighborhood residents (such as non-resident business owners and property owners) be eligible to vote or hold office in CTM?”**

If a majority of residents vote “Yes” on this question, nonresidents will be allowed to vote and, if CTM’s bylaws also change in a subsequent vote, will be allowed to hold office on CTM. If a majority of residents vote “No” on this question, nonresidents will NOT be allowed to vote nor will they be allowed to hold office.

Non-resident business owners or property owners are not eligible to vote in this special vote.

<b>Outcome of vote on the Ballot Question and Proposed Bylaws changes</b>		
<b>Outcome ↓</b>	<b>Voting eligibility ↓</b>	<b>Board of Trustees eligibility ↓</b>
As of now, <b>Current Status</b> →:	Nonresidents business and property owners <u>can</u> vote.	Nonresidents business and property owners <u>cannot</u> hold office
If a majority votes “YES” on Ballot Question →	Nonresidents business and property owners <u>can</u> vote	Non-residents <u>might</u> be able to hold office - if bylaws also change (items A & K), which requires a $\frac{2}{3}$ vote
If a majority votes “NO” on Ballot Question→	Nonresidents business and property owners <u>cannot</u> vote	Nonresidents business and property owners <u>cannot</u> hold office
