Special Vote per City Ordinance 220-1989

Ballot Question

"Shall CTM Members that are not neighborhood residents (such as non-resident business owners and property owners) be eligible to vote or hold office in CTM?"

If a majority of residents vote "Yes" on this question, nonresidents will be allowed to vote and, if CTM's bylaws also change in a subsequent vote, will be allowed to hold office on CTM. If a majority of residents vote "No" on this question, nonresidents will NOT be allowed to vote nor will they be allowed to hold office.

Non-resident business owners or property owners are not eligible to vote in this special vote.
